7.1.10. Code of Conduct

All the students are instructed to follow traditional dress code inside the campus to maintain their discipline. Moreover, violations and ragging are strictly prohibited in the campus. In case of disobedience, it will result in severe action and a 15 days suspension with a disciplinary action. Students are forbidden to engage in illegal activities such as active party, political and communal activities. No statement shall be posted or circulated on the college campus without the written consent from the principal.

Parents/Guardians must obtain prior permission from the college office to meet the students. Students are instructed to keep their belongings safe and should not wear any expensive things/jewelry. It is mandatory that the students should properly attend the internal test and model exams regularly without fail. Students, those who have less than 75% attendance are not permitted to attend the examination. Students should always follow the rules and regulation of the college inside the campus. Students are expected to maintain their best disciplines inside and outer side of the campus. During the time of admission, the students are given Code of Conduct form, which is prepared by the Monitoring Committee of our college.
